

Quality Management Coordinator

The University of Iowa Hospitals & Clinics has an opening for a full-time Quality Management Coordinator in the office of Clinical Quality, Safety and Performance Improvement. The Quality Management Coordinator will work to develop and coordinate components of the UIHC Performance Improvement Program. This position will facilitate improvement activities utilizing the DMAIC process, and to serve as a resource to assist and train others on performance improvement methodologies and other health care quality initiatives. This position will provide all levels of management, physicians, and clinical staff with accurate and timely information for effective decision making utilizing internal and external decision support systems.

REQUIREMENTS:

- A Master's degree in a health care related field is required, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Reasonable demonstrated knowledge (1-3 years) of healthcare outcomes and performance improvement initiatives/techniques.
- Demonstrated proficiency with computers, including Excel, Word, and PowerPoint is required. Ability to format tables, retrieve data via queries, and create presentations via PowerPoint.
- Demonstrated excellent communication skills, both written and verbal.
- Demonstrated proficiency in professional writing.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- A Bachelor's degree in nursing is strongly desired.
- A current Iowa RN license is strongly desired
- Specific training and certification in performance improvement techniques (i.e. Six Sigma Green or Black Belt) is strongly desired.
- Professional certification related to healthcare quality (i.e. CPHQ, ASQ) is strongly desired.
- Previous clinical experience in an academic medical center is strongly desired.
- Some knowledge of University and Regent policies, procedures, and regulations is desirable.
