Course Overview

This one-day Emergency Nursing Pediatric Course Renewal program is designed to review the important information and skills relevant to nursing care of the pediatric patient in the emergency setting, as written into the ENPC course by the Emergency Nurses Association, and if successfully completed, renews the ENPC 4-year certification period.

Educational Objectives

Upon completion of this program, the participant will be able to:

- Describe the characteristics of life-threatening illness and injury to children and the assessment techniques to identify them.
- Identify the anatomic and physiologic characteristics of children as a basis for signs and symptoms.
- Identify the most frequent causes of illness or injury in children.
- Identify the appropriate nursing diagnoses and expected outcomes based on the assessment findings, plan specific interventions, and evaluate their effectiveness vs patient outcomes.

Faculty

Intended Audience

This course is intended for licensed RNs who are currently certified in ENPC and wish to renew that certification. Upon registration, the participant will submit verification of current ENPC certification (copy of card). Those with expired ENPC cards must attend the 2-day verification course.
