## Course Overview

The 48-hour EMS Refresher Training Program is designed to assist EMTs of all levels in maintaining up-to-date proficiency in critical knowledge and skills pertinent to providing emergency care in the field. The program adheres to the refresher program standards set forth by the U.S. Department of Transportation and the National Registry of EMTs.

## Unique Features

- Modular design to allow all levels of EMTs to satisfy their individual recertification requirements.
- Weekend scheduling over two non-consecutive weekends to allow rapid completion of the course with minimal off-duty time commitment.
- Conveniently scheduled just before the end of the National Registry certification period, allowing last minute completion of outstanding continuing education requirements.

## EMS Refresher Course Structure/Content

The re-registration process under the National Standards for NREMT calls for completion of either a formal refresher course or continuing education structured around the content of the National Refresher, which includes “mandatory” and “flexible” core content areas.

### Mandatory Core Content

The Mandatory Core Content was developed based upon assessment and patient care tasks that were identified by EMTs in the practice analysis to have a high potential for harm yet a low frequency of delivery. Registered NREMT-EMT-Basics, Intermediate 85/99s and NREMT-Paramedics must receive education over every topic listed in the Mandatory Core Content.

### Flexible Core Content:

The Flexible Core Content represents education over topics identified by EMTs to have both high potential for harm and high frequency of delivery. NREMT-Intermediate 85/99s, NREM Paramedics, states, or employers may choose which patient assessment and care tasks they wish to review based upon individual, system or state needs assessments.

Topics included are anatomy and physiology, initial patient assessment and management, airway and ventilation, pathophysiology of shock, and general pharmacology, trauma assessment and management of shock and chest, open abdominal, spinal injuries, and burns. Cardiopulmonary material will focus on providing ventilatory support, cardiac arrest management, cardiovascular compromise support, and post resuscitation care. Medical issues on drug abuse, near drowning and allergic reactions will be rounded out with lectures covering children in medical distress.

## General

The EMS Refresher Course will be conducted in the Emergency Medicine Conference Room from 8am - 5pm each day unless otherwise stated. Lunch is on your own. Space will be limited to the first 100 registrants per day.

The EMS Refresher Course will be conducted in the Emergency Medicine Conference Room — Elevator F to Lower Level, 0070 RCP.

The complete 48-hour program is conducted over two non-consecutive three-day weekends. Each day consists of 8 CEHs divided into am and pm modules.
