PALS RENEWAL

Thank you for your interest in the Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) Provider Renewal courses.

Although we do not require proof of CPR certification before registration, you must be proficient in CPR before participating in this course. Your CPR skills will be evaluated during the PALS clinical cases, so please be familiar with the American Heart Association CPR guidelines.

Successful completion of PALS Renewal does not renew your CPR card.

Please read the course participant eligibility policies carefully and determine your status prior to registration.

\$45 DEPOSIT — RNs, Respiratory Therapists, Physical Therapists, Radiology Technologists

A \$45 deposit is required with registration and will be returned upon course completion and return of materials in good condition.

Nursing CEU credit is available for \$18 to those paying a deposit only. (Separate check from course deposit, payable to "EMSLRC").

\$45 REDUCED FEE — All physicians, physician assistants, advanced registered nurse practitioners, dentists, UI CCOM students and others.

A \$45 fee will be required with completed registration. Participant retains course materials. Nursing CEU and EMS provider CEH credit fees are included. You will receive a refund of all but \$10 of your registration fee if registration is canceled two weeks prior to the course date. No tuition refund will be provided if cancellation is less than two weeks prior to the beginning of the course.

All registrations must be postmarked or FAXED no later than six (6) business days before the first day of class.

Course Pre-requisites

Students are required to study materials and complete a pre-course written exam. They must:

- Have BCLS for Healthcare providers, basic airway management and IV skills
- Know basic pharmacology
- Be able to recognize basic ECGs

Educational Objectives

Upon completion of this program, each participant will be able to:

- 1) Recognize the signs and symptoms of impending cardiac arrest in children and perform a rapid cardiopulmonary assessment.
- 2) Discuss common fluids and emergency care drugs used in the prevention and treatment of cardiopulmonary failure and arrest in children.
- 3) Perform basic life support and demonstrate bag-valve-mask ventilation procedures.
- 4) Discuss, demonstrate and practice using airway adjuncts for pediatric patients.
- 5) Discuss vascular access in children and demonstrate intraosseous line placement.
- 6) Discuss and demonstrate cardiac rhythm recognition in children.
- 7) Discuss and manage pediatric patients in shock, respiratory failure and cardiopulmonary arrest.
- 8) Discuss the principles of the primary survey and resuscitation of the pediatric trauma patient with emphasis on shock management.
