BLS Training Center Faculty Orientation and Renewal Course

Purpose

BLS Training Center Faculty Orientation and Renewal Course is designed to teach experienced Basic Life Support instructors the knowledge and skills needed for the accurate instruction, evaluation, monitoring and mentoring of Instructor candidates for proficiency in Basic Life Support. The participants will renew their provider skills while being monitored by Regional Faculty.

Educational Objectives

Upon completion of this program, each participant will be able to:

- Define the role of BLS training center faculty in monitoring and mentoring of instructors.
- Demonstrate and evaluate all BLS skills using a scenario presentation.
- Discuss methods of promoting and expanding BLS training in their communities.
- Successfully complete provider and instructor level practical skills and written evaluation.
- Discuss quality improvement and the role of monitoring and mentoring.

Pre-Requisites

Each candidate must complete the Core Instructor program prior to the course and submit a copy of their completion certificate.

Candidates must submit the completed BLS Training Center Faculty application and have at least two years experience as a BLS Instructor and participated in a minimum of four BLS courses within that time frame. If renewing BLS Faculty status, candidates must include one new instructor program or one instructor renewal course.

Demonstrate willingness and desire to teach in accordance with the scientific and program guidelines of the AHA.

Each candidate must make a commitment to teach four provider or renewal courses in two years according to the standards of the AHA and additionally one instructor or instructor renewal course.

Each candidate must demonstrate acceptable provider skills and complete the provider written exam with a score of 90 percent.
