Course Overview

This is the ONLY 1-day TNCC Refresher course for 2008.

The Emergency Nurses Association (ENA) only allows 1-day TNCC Refresher programs through April 2008. (6th Edition programs will be 2-day courses.)

The Emergency Nurses Association (ENA) developed the Trauma Nursing Core Course (TNCC) in order to provide the learner with the appropriate knowledge necessary to function effectively in a written and psychomotor evaluation of trauma nursing skills for emergency resuscitation.

This course certification by the ENA is good for four (4) years.

The 8-hour TNCC Refresher Course has been designed to provide the opportunity for those currently certified in TNCC to refresh their knowledge and skills prior to retesting and recertifying in this state-required program for Trauma Care Facilities.

Educational Objectives

Upon completion of this program, each currently-certified TNCC nurse will be able to discuss the etiology, mechanism of injury, assessment, signs and symptoms, diagnostic procedures, triage, and nursing/medical interventions of the following:

- a. shock
- b. brain & craniofacial
- c. spinal trauma
- d. chest trauma
- e. pediatric trauma
- f. geriatric trauma
- g. abdominal
- h. extremity
- i. burns
- j. multiple trauma
- k. stabilization and transport

Pre-requisites

In order to take this TNCC Refresher course, the registrant must be within four years of TNCC expiration date. This course certification by the ENA is good for four (4) years with NO grace period.

Continuing Education Credits

This course is held in cooperation with the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics Department of Nursing, an Iowa Board of Nursing approved provider Number 34. Participants will receive 0.76 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) or 7.6 contact hours for full time attendance to this program.

The Emergency Nurses Association will issue a card verifying the successful completion of the TNCC (provider). Expiration of the verification will occur four (4) years from the date of issue.
