

## CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST

The Department of Family Medicine at the University of Iowa is seeking a full-time Clinical Psychologist who is passionate about education, patient care and the opportunity to participate in the development of the next generation of Family Medicine physicians.

The candidate selected for this position will be familiar with the core competency objectives in behavioral science residency education, and s/he will have skills in planning and implementing training activities. Training will emphasize the doctor-patient relationship, interviewing and counseling skills, normal psychosocial growth and development, stages of stress in the family life cycle, and assessment and management of difficulties seen in a primary care population. S/he must be licensed or eligible for licensure in the State of Iowa as a health services provider.

The individual selected will spend 40% effort in education, 20% effort in direct supervision/teaching of residents, 30% independently counseling patients, and 10% time in administration.

Faculty rank and salary will be commensurate with experience.
