

# **Brain Structure & Function in Relatives of People with Schizophrenia**

## **What is the purpose of this study?**

The purpose of this study is to determine if there are differences in brain structure and function among relatives of people diagnosed with schizophrenia compared to people with no family history of schizophrenia.

## **What will occur during the study?**

The study visit will last 5-6 hours and will involve cognitive testing (memory tests, visual tests, etc.), a MRI, neurological examination and blood draw.

## **Who is eligible?**

People between the ages of 13-25 and have a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> degree (sibling, aunt, uncle, parent, grandparent) diagnosed with schizophrenia or related disorder.

## **Will I be paid for participating?**

Compensation is available for participating in this study.
