

## Staff Nurse Positions Available in Behavioral Health Services

Within the [Behavioral Health Services](#) division are nursing units to care for child, adolescent, adult, and geriatric psychiatry; neuropsychiatry, patients with both medical and psychiatric problems; and housed outpatients. The division includes outpatient services for adult psychiatric partial hospital and chemical dependency. It also includes clinics for adult and child psychiatry.

**Note:** Initial two week internal posting period dates are identified for all new positions. To submit a contract transfer for a nursing position covered by SEIU, please submit Form 700, Application for Transfer/Status Change, indicating the position of interest to Nursing Human Resources no later than 4:30 PM on the last day of the posting period. Positions will remain posted until filled.

### **Neuropsychiatric Unit (2JPW) (Internal Recruitment)**

3/10 – 3/24/10 90% Rotating, 8 hour shifts. Previous experience in a mental-health setting desirable. Strong communication skills, tolerance for active work environment with potential for violence and/or negative behavior.

### **Medicine-Psychiatric Unit (3BT) (Internal Recruitment)**

3/17 – 3/31/10 50% Rotating, 8 and 12 hour shifts. If work 12 hours on weekends, work every 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend. If work 8 hours on weekends, work every other weekend.

*\* Orientation to a new position usually comprises full-time hours. Benefit accruals and compensation are based on percentage of the appointment.*
