As a Clinical Resource Unit (CRU) nurse, you'll work on your choice of specialized teams of adult inpatient units! Team 1 includes our intensive care units and Team 2 specializes in the Intermediate and step-down environments. Team 3 focuses on our oncology populations, while Team 4 is designed for the generalist medical-surgical nurse. Team 5 comprises our five Behavioral Health units.

Note: Initial two week internal posting period dates are identified for all new positions. To submit a contract transfer for a nursing position covered by SEIU, please submit Form 700, Application for Transfer/Status Change, indicating the position of interest to Nursing Human Resources no later than 5:00 PM on the last day of the posting period. Positions will remain posted until filled.

Team 2 (Intensive and Specialty Services) = Medical Cardiology, Neurosurgery, Medical/Surgical Cardiology Unit, Burn Treatment/Trauma Unit Intermediate Pulmonary Care Unit:

Team 4 (Medical/Surgical Services) = Orthopedics, Medicine Specialty, Medicine Psychiatric Unit, GI Surgery, Neurology, Transplant, and Ophthalmology :
