This toolkit is designed to provide guidance for healthcare leaders in promoting adoption of evidence-based practices. The toolkit includes information on preparing, implementing, and evaluating evidence-based practices, and includes forms and electronic templates for various activities such as selection of a topic, literature search strategies, research critique, process implementation, and evaluation.

This on-line computer course offers background information to introduce evidence-based practice. The course contains an historical perspective and summary of the current state of science of evidence-based practice. Interventions that have been effective in promoting practice change among clinicians are discussed.  **Advanced Practice Institute: Promoting Adoption of Evidence-Based Practice (Conducted in Iowa City, Iowa)** **\$1500/individual**

The Institute is a 3-day workshop held in Iowa City, Iowa, that provides an opportunity for nurse leaders to learn advanced skills in evidence-based practice, the role of evidence-based practice facilitation, and strategies for developing the organizational infrastructure necessary for an evidence-based practice program. Learning is facilitated through didactic presentations, discussion, facilitated work time and scheduled consultations. (Attendance from a single organization is limited to four participants to promote networking across organizations and settings.)
