Four Seasons

The images that reflect the seasons are created from brass, copper, tin and aluminum; found objects, familiar to the viewer but snipped, layered and hammered to create a collage.

One of my main challenges is to take a familiar concept- the changing of the four seasons- and present it in a unique way that encourages a fresh appreciation of this universal theme. Mark Stevenson

The series is created using objects very familiar to the viewer, such as metal cups, lids, trays and utensils. The series is a good example of how common objects by placement and artistic expression can make visible the artist's concept of something as universal as the "changing of seasons"
